- The Competition Law has been passed on December 3, 2004 by the *11th* National Assembly of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam at its 6th session.
- Legal enforcement: from the 1st July, 2005.

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- Competition-restricting acts
- Unfair competition acts
- Order and procedures for settling competition cases
- Vietnam Competition Authorities

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ENFORCEMENT OF COMPETITION LAW



Drafting guidelines

- Decree on providing detailed regulations and guidelines for implementation of the law on competition
- Decree on administration multilevel marketing practices
- Decree on handling Violations of the Laws Concerning Competition
- Decree on establishment, functions, organization structure and powers of Competition Administration Department.
- Decree on establishment, functions, organization structure and powers of Competition Council.

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Competition advocacy

- Building strategic alliances with other economic actors/stakeholders
- Doing or getting research done into possible areas of economic governance
- Conducting public meetings and seminars for all stakeholders to demonstrate the benefits of enforcement actions,
- Build institutional credibility

- Conduct economic research to understand national, regional and international markets in key sectors for Vietnam and advice in relation to the adoption of targeted strategies in these sectors;
- > Review implementing decrees to the Law on Competition and define missing elements.



- ✓ Assistance in the adoption of any additional relevant implementing decrees to the Law on Competition
- Train competition investigators;
- ✓ Undertake measures that enhance transparency and public appreciation of competition policy and actions
