

Tips for quality proposals



Some things to remember while drafting:

- Are the objectives SMART?
- Be precise about who will benefit and how stakeholders will be involved
- Show that you've done your **homework**: use your research to answer the questions
- Be accurate in developing your budget
- Remember the audience: not all proposal readers will be an expert

Project Implementation Phase



 Projects must be implemented in line with the Guidebook on APEC Projects

New ed. of the Guidebook - 1 Jan 2011

- Projects completed within two financial years
- Monitoring reports (mandatory) submitted at
 6 month intervals: next due 1 August 2011
- Completion report (mandatory) submitted within 2 months of project completion

- Multi-year project pilot from session 2
- Continued strengthening of project monitoring and evaluation
- Changes in fund disbursement procedures

Multi-year projects



Pilot starting from approval session 2:

- Capacity building initiatives
- Maximum of \$500,000 over 5 years
- Minimum co-funding & co-sponsoring needed
- Must be a strategic priority for SOMs / Committees / SFOM
- Must have involvement of 2 APEC fora & external stakeholders
