Strengthening food security

For sustainable agriculture development and stable markets:

- increase transparency, monitoring and information exchange
- develop markets' infrastructure, reduce costs and losses in food chains
- liberalize investment
- promote innovative agricultural development
- improve quality and safety of food products
- reach easier conformity to food safety standards
- aim at provision of food for socially vulnerable population groups
- elaborate measures on responsible maintenance of ecosystems

APEC will continue... to address food security and food safety challenges by promoting sustainable development of the agricultural sector through means such as increasing production and productivity and reducing post-harvest losses, and by facilitating investment, trade, and markets (2010 Growth Strategy)





Establishing reliable supply chains

For better connectivity of supply chains within APEC region and outside:

- tackle the bottlenecks
- contribute to transparency and visibility of supply chains
- identify and remove restrictions on information exchange
- apply promising tracking technologies
- advance in logistics, navigation and customs technologies
- respond to possible risks, ensure safe operation and protection
- strengthen capacities in emergency prevention and improve related coordination
