

- Competition in Hospital Services
 - Conditions for and repercussions of price and quality competition in the hospital services sector
 - What could be appropriate institutional frameworks and policy reforms for economies to introduce to allow more worthwhile competition in hospital services?
- Unilateral Disclosure of Information
 - Identifying criteria that can help agencies distinguish anticompetitive unilateral announcements from legitimate business practices
 - Exploring whether there are legal impediments to pursuing purely unilateral conduct which has anticompetitive effects
