


#### Osaka Action Agenda

In "Chapter 16 Competition Policy "of the TPP agreement "Recognising the value of the APEC Competition Law and Policy Database in enhancing the transparency of national competition laws, policies and enforcement activities, each Party shall endeavour to maintain and update its information on that database"
